1. Venue:

2. Registration

3. Rules

The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024, the prescriptions of Sail Canada, and the Optimist Dinghy Rules (except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race), and the Sailing Instructions.

4. Eligibility and Entry
