## Sail Manitoba Infractions and Consequences

Rule #4 of the Team Code of Conduct Policy states: I will not partake in unacceptable behaviors listed in the Manitoba Sailing Team Infractions and Consequences document.

MINOR	<ul> <li>Late for team meetings, training, or regattas</li> <li>Inappropriate dress</li> <li>Abusive, racist or sexist comments or behavior</li> <li>Deliberate damage or misuse of any Sail Manitoba equipment (van, coach boat, gear). Examples include but are not limited to: <ul> <li>Stickers on van</li> <li>Coins in the seat belt slots</li> <li>Food and garbage in the van</li> </ul> </li> <li>Failure to use your seatbelt in the team van</li> <li>Violation of travel rules/violation of host club rules</li> <li>Inappropriate behavior and/or cleanliness in hotel rooms or at sites, includes littering and failure to clean up</li> <li>Breaking curfew</li> <li>Unsportsmanlike conduct including rude and/or foul language</li> <li>Lack of courtesy or respect for fellow team mates, competitors, coaches, managers, volunteers, media</li> <li>Lying or cheating</li> <li>Jeopardizing the safety of yourself or others</li> <li>Complete disregard of any of the minor infractions listed above</li> <li>Failure to perform consequences for minor infractions, thereby showing total disregard of the coach's authority</li> <li>Damage of a more serious nature of any property, while participating at a team event.</li> </ul>	Head Coach or Designate Head Coach or Designate, and Team Committee	<ul> <li>The Head Coach or his/her designate will work with you to try to create a positive change in your behavior.</li> <li>She/he will discuss the problem with you so that you know you have done something which is unacceptable; this may be all that is necessary for a positive change in your behavior.</li> <li>The Head Coach or his/her designate will deal with you on an individual basis, and may use an appropriate consequence, listed below, as a deterrent.</li> <li>Verbal and/or written apology</li> <li>Other potential consequences: Physical Activity Early curfew Grounding Confinement Suspension from team activities Volunteer work for Sail Manitoba</li> <li>Verbal and written apology for behavior</li> <li>Reparation for any damage done.</li> <li>Volunteer work for Sail Manitoba</li> <li>Possible loss of funding</li> <li>In extreme cases, disciplinary action(s) described in the Manitoba Sailing Team Code of Conduct</li> </ul>
