Executive Committee Member Nomination Guidelines

The Executive Committee is comprised of elected officers who hold the positions of Past President, President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, and four Members-at-Large. The nine Officers are elected by a simple majority of the Board of Directors at an Annual General Meeting. Club/Association members or individual members of Sail Manitoba in good standing may be elected as Officers on the Executive Committee.

Election as an Officer, a candidate must:

- Be a paid member in good standing of a member club /class association
- Be an individual member in good standing of Sail Manitoba.
- Be at least eighteen years of age, with power under law to contract
- Consent to volunteer for the duration of the term in the Executive position in which they are interested.
- Not have any known impediments that are likely to result in their removal during their term.
- Have no commercial conflict of interest within the sport of sailing
- Although not exclusively a pre-requisite for eligibility, efforts should be made to have representation from all regions of the province.

Positions to be elected at the Annual General Meeting on Wednesday, November 20, 2024:

Secretary

In order for the Board of Directors and Executive Committee to be free to discuss matters, consider information, and make decisions, the secretary will assist with meetings and is responsible for the following: Keeping minutes of meetings and recording all votes.

Members at Large (two positions)

The Members at Large do not have predefined roles but are elected to represent the general interests of Sail Manitoba members, provide their input and vote on matters being dealt with by the Executive Committee, and render other assistance required by the Executive Committee.

Note: *the Executive Committee is different from the Board of Directors of Sail MB. The Board is not an elected body and is comprised of the Commodore of member Clubs/Class Associations or their designates.*
