



Selection Criteria for the 2021/22 Canada Summer Games

Competitors who want to qualify for the Canada Summer Games (CSG) must indicate their intent to qualify with the Technical Director of Spring 2021.

Classification

Able Bodied

Must be under 21 years of age and no younger than 15 years of age as of December 31, 2022.
Date of Birth between: January 1, 2001 - December 31, 2007.

Para

Must be under 37 years of age and no younger than 17 years of age as of December 31, 2022.
Date of Birth between: January 1, 1985 – December 31, 2005.
Competition is restricted to athletes with a Disability Classification of up to 7.

Male Category ***Singlehanded – Laser***
Doublehanded – 29er

Female Category ***Singlehanded – Radial***
Doublehanded – 29er

Mixed Para Sailing ***Singlehanded – 2.4mR***

Rules

The qualifying regattas will be conducted according to the sailing instructions of the events as prepared by the host yacht club and its race committee.

The competitors who are attempting to qualify will be ranked according to their placing within each class at each of the regattas and earn points reflecting their ranking.

At the end of the qualifying series the points from each regatta will be added together. In the event of a tie, they will be ranked by the number of times a boat scored better than the other tied boats. The highest placed competitor will qualify first and the next placed competitor will be the alternate.

Competitors are reminded that they must be a member of a Yacht Club and Sail Manitoba/Sail Canada to compete in the qualification events. Competitors do not have to be a member of the Manitoba Sailing Team to compete in the qualifier.

Competitors who are selected must match the competitor's eligibility rules of the Canada Summer Games. The finalists must join the Manitoba Sailing Team as a High-Performance Team Member. The decision to compete in the CSG on the Manitoba Sailing Team is a serious commitment and it is mandatory to attend the announced CSG team events in 2022.

If a competitor is not able to participate in these events a request must be made to the Head Coach stating the reason and showing a detailed training plan leading up to the CSG. The Head Coach will then make a final decision if this competitor is eligible to compete for Manitoba. If the competitor cannot fulfill the requirements, the alternate will be declared to be the Manitoba representative at the CSG.

*Appeals for the 2021 Qualifiers will be accepted until November 15, 2021, and to be submitted in writing to the President of Sail Manitoba. This is the highest authority that appeals can be made to for the CSG team selection.

**Appeals for the 2022 Qualifiers will be accepted seven days after the last Qualifying Event, and to be submitted in writing to the President of Sail Manitoba. This is the highest authority that appeals can be made to for the CSG team selection.
