SANCTION POLICY

1. Statement

This policy has been established to document the criteria required for Sail Manitoba to sanction a sailing regatta or series of races. Sail Manitoba may sanction the entire event, part there of or any “on the water” event.

2. Definitions

Event – a series of races that constitutes a regatta including all other scheduled activities including seminars and social events.

Regatta Series – a season series culminating in final standings.

3. Event Prerequisites

- A. The event/race committee demonstrates the required level of quality, with controls in place to ensure the event/regatta series remains at a high level. These prerequisites shall include but not necessarily be limited to the following:
 - 1 The event must have a Regatta/Race Chair appointed
 - 2 A Race Officer must be appointed who meets the Sail Canada Race Management level capable in running a series of races.
 - 3 A Protest Committee must be established to address protest in a fair and equitable manner.
 - 4 On the water safety must be capable of addressing emergencies of competitors
 - 5 Notice of Race meets the criteria set forth in the Racing Rules of Sailing
 - 6 Sailing Instructions must meet the criteria set forth in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
 - 7 All racing participants must be a full member of Sail Manitoba or any other Provincial Sailing Association, Sail Canada or US Sailing.
- B. All learn to sail programs at member clubs will be sanctioned by Sail Manitoba.
- C. The request for sanctioning of events or the learn to sail schedule must be received in writing at the office (email is valid) at least 30 days before the first part of the sanction event or races begin.
- D. The event cannot be sanctioned in the Notice of Race unless sanctioning has been officially received from Sail Manitoba.

4. Funding

An event sanctioned by Sail Manitoba might be eligible for funding. In order to get funding Clubs have to send an application to the office.

5. Insurance

Sail Manitoba will not allocate Sport Manitoba insurance to an event or race series unless it has been approved as a sanctioned event. Sail Manitoba offers a \$5 million liability insurance and an accident insurance for all sanctioned events. Event organizers should consult/review the current Sport Manitoba Insurance Program, which is available at the office or can be viewed on our website

6. Approval

Sail Manitoba will authorize a sailing event, a sailing schedule or learn to sail program by giving official approval in writing. The notice of approval will come from the Executive Director.

7. Sanction Committee

- A. The sanction committee will consist of the President, Executive Director and the Chair of the Officials Committee.
- B. In case of dispute the club's request will be reviewed by the sanction committee. Their decision to sanction or not to sanction cannot be appealed.
- B. The sanction committee will meet as required to answer requests for sanctioning and may do through conference calls or e-mails.

8. Policy Responsibility, Review and Approval

The administration and review of this policy is the responsibility of the ED. This policy was first approved by the Board of Directors of Sail Manitoba on March 12, 2007. It was reviewed and re-approved by the Board of Directors in May 2017. The date for the next re-approval is May 2020.
